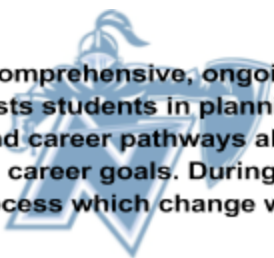


Academic and Career Plan Process

Nicolet's Academic and Career Planning is a comprehensive, ongoing process, culminating in the post secondary plan. The educational process assists students in planning and managing their school program. The goal is to provide a variety of academic and career pathways allowing students to individualize their course of study to meet personal, college, and career goals. During each grade, students will understand academic and career plans are an ongoing process which change with new experiences and may be revised.



6th Grade Outcomes



- ❑ Understand the 16 various courses of study/career pathways and career clusters
- ❑ Explore the courses of study and select one to research
- ❑ Develop educational goals targeted to a specific career pathway

10th Grade Outcomes



- ❑ Research potential careers and colleges
- ❑ Reevaluate Academic Career Plan to make sure course selection/electives match
- ❑ Explore Clubs, sports, pre-college programs, summer camps, college visits
- ❑ Review school course offerings and selections supporting personal goals and revise ACP.

7th Grade Outcomes



- ❑ Complete interest inventories to learn more about you and the world of work
- ❑ Understand how to set academic and personal goals
- ❑ Learn how to better use school resources as you gather information, research career pathways and clusters in preparation of high school transition.

11th Grade Outcomes



- ❑ Research college options and the college application process: Complete a college search; Select colleges matching interests; Visit admission college representatives; Attend college fairs; Review college applications and essays.
- ❑ Prepare for and take assessments, review results and determine how they match personal, college and career goals.
- ❑ Explore clubs, sports, pre-college programs, summer camps, college visits
- ❑ Review and select courses supporting personal goals and revise ACP

8th Grade Outcomes



- ❑ Understand graduation requirements and high school expectations
- ❑ Set academic and personal goals, complete interest inventories, identify educational and career interests which assist with high school course selection.
- ❑ Develop study skills, time management, homework completion so students are prepared for high school and post-secondary achievement
- ❑ Introduce students to the course selection process, College and Career Readiness Guide, and Selection Forms.

9th Grade Outcomes



- ❑ Meeting with High School Counselor to begin transition. Review High School Graduation requirements and College Admissions for each:
 - Nicolet, University of Wisconsin System and Selective Colleges.
- ❑ Understand skills needed for future careers and develop sequence of preparation for college and careers using the 16 Career Clusters.
- ❑ Identify personal and career interests which may impact goals and plans.
- ❑ Review school course offerings and selections supporting personal goals and revise ACP.

12th Grade Outcomes



- ❑ Review assessment results and determine how they match personal college and career goals.
 - ❑ Explore financial aid options and complete a financial plan to support your goals.
- ❑ Review ACP to ensure it accurately reflections college and career goals.
- ❑ Complete applications, request transcripts, and teacher recommendations to assist in transition to college and career goals.
