The distinction does more than honor its recipients. It also further illustrates the great value of the academic programs at Nicolet High School, increases the pride former students, staff and faculty have for the school, and provides role models for current students.

Criteria for Selection

Recipients must be a graduate of Nicolet High School and have earned distinction in the following:

1. Professional Achievement and Career Distinction: The recipient has attained recognition through his or her efforts in their chosen career or vocation.
2. Service to Community/Society: The recipient exhibits integrity and a demonstrated commitment to service through an interest in bettering the lives of others through volunteer efforts with a focus on education.

Method of Nomination

Nominations may be made for the Knights to Remember Award by any individual, group or organization.

In addition to completing and submitting the [Knight To Remember Nomination Form](#) (required), nominators are encouraged to provide supporting items that further distinguish the nominee. Such items include, but are not limited to:

Letter of nomination written by the nominator (required)
Nominee's current biography or curriculum vitae
Other items of interest which could include:

Awards/recognitions
Newspaper and magazine articles
Testimonials
