NICOLET HIGH SCHOOL MERIT AWARD

Established by the PTSO in 1987 to provide recognition for students who demonstrate commitment to the Nicolet School Community.

> Recognition for students who:

- participate in school activities,
- exhibit a positive attitude in their classes,
- ❖ volunteer for/at Nicolet, Nicolet Recreational Department, or Nicolet partner schools
- attend school sponsored activities/events, and
- have shown leadership through positive behavior & citizenship.

Qualifications:

- Membership in a club, athletic team, extra-curricular club, cast/crew in play and/or musical.
 Participation must be certified by team/activity advisor.
- ❖ Projecting a positive attitude towards schoolwork. **To be certified by TWO teachers.**
- ❖ Performance of five (5) hours of service for/at Nicolet High School, Nicolet Recreation Department or any of the following Nicolet Partner Schools: Bayside Middle School; Glen Hills Middle School; Maple Dale Middle School; Hillel Academy; Holy Family; MJDS; St. Eugene's; St. John's Lutheran; St. Monica's.

NOTE: Student cannot claim service for which s/he receives money or graduation credits or fulfillment of a requirement for another school organization. For example, a student cannot apply the same tutoring hours toward fulfillment of both National Honor Society and the Merit Award. Also, service work cannot be claimed as attendance at a school-sponsored event. It must be one or the other. **To be certified by an adult supervising the activity.**

- Attendance at **5 or more school-sponsored events** (sports, social or fine arts events). Students are encouraged to attend at least one of each type of event. **To be certified by parent on form.**

> Eligibility:

Students should not have been suspended, violated any Cease and Desist Agreements, should have shown growth in self control (if applicable) and have been an overall positive student this school year. Violations of school policies and/or athletic code, disciplinary referrals or truancy may disqualify a student from eligibility for the school year of the infraction. Approval of applications will be made by Nicolet High School office. *All applicants will be notified of acceptance/denial status in April.*

Recognition for Merit Award accepted applicants:

- Applicants will receive a specially designed award at either the year-end meetings in May or at the senior breakfast in June.
- In addition, senior recipients of the 4 year plaque will be acknowledged in the graduation program.
- Applicants will be recognized on bulletin board display and in the Knight's Yearbook.

NOTE: To help guide you, a total of five (5) pages should be completed and submitted on time before you can be considered for the Nicolet Merit Award. **Student is responsible for having sections A through E completed before submitting packet to the High School Office for approval by due date:**
