# 2021 INTERNATIONAL SCIENCE AND ENGINEERING FAIR

Two Nicolet students received awards at the prestigious International Science and Engineering Fair, competing against more than 1,800 students from 64 countries.

Sophomore **Ethan Zentner** won the Grand Award of First Place in the category of Materials Science for his project titled, "The Effects of Lattice Structure on SLA 3D Printed Piezoelectric PVDF." Ethan also won an ISEF Special Award. Ethan Zentner has been awarded \$5,000 and a CIA STEAM Challenge Coin from the Central Intelligence Agency in the category of Material Science.

Junior Marshall Vielmetti won the Grand Award of Fourth Place in the category of Systems Software for his project "Enterprise Scale Inventory Optimization: Building a Modern Web Application to Improve Inventory and Supply Chain Optimization by Incorporating Advanced Analysis and Business Intelligence into Existing Techniques with a Cohesive, User-friendly Solution."

Additionally, a \$1,000 grant was awarded to Nicolet High School and a \$1,000 grant was awarded to the Nicolet Science Fair.




# **ART AWARDS**
